SUBJECT: Agreement Nos. 47816A, 47816B and 47816C for Site Investigation and Remediation Services – AECOM Technical Services, Inc.; Kleinfelder, Inc.; and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc., Respectively

SUMMARY

The proposed Agreement Nos. 47816A, 47816B and 47816C (Agreements) – AECOM Technical Services, Inc. (AECOM); Kleinfelder, Inc. (Kleinfelder); and Stantec Consulting Services, Inc. (Stantec), respectively, will provide as-needed site investigation and remediation services for a term of five years and an aggregate amount not to exceed \$30,000,000 (budgeted). The Agreements are the result of a competitive process under Request for Proposal (RFP) No. 90708.

LADWP requires as-needed professional services for specialized environmental assessments, the preparation of remedial investigation/site characterization reports, and to perform human and environmental health risk assessment and toxicological studies. These activities are required by the California Department of Toxic Substances Control, the Los Angeles Regional Water Quality Control Board, and other regulatory agencies for LADWP property acquisitions. The services will minimize future LADWP environmental liability, and provide site environmental conditions to various LADWP divisions during the planning and implementation phases of various environmental transactions and investigations.

City Council approval is not required.

RECOMMENDATION

It is recommended that the Board of Water and Power Commissioners adopt the attached Resolution authorizing execution of Agreements to AECOM, Kleinfelder, and Stantec, respectively.

ALTERNATIVES CONSIDERED

There is no alternative to contracting out these services. LADWP does not have employees with specialized knowledge and certifications to provide comprehensive environmental assessment and remediation services on a wide spectrum of disciplines and activities such as toxicology studies, environmental health risk assessment and associated modeling, and remediation system design and implementation. Due to the complexity of the assessments, certification would take years to obtain and would not be a feasible or a practical approach. .

The projects to be supported by these Agreements include capital improvement projects, new infrastructure and upgrades for regulatory compliance, and emergency repair activities. Contracting out these services will greatly reduce the risk of penalties and violations that would delay projects that ensure reliability, sustainability, and development of LADWP's renewable power supply.

FINANCIAL INFORMATION

The Agreements are for a term of five years. The total maximum aggregate expenditure under these Agreements shall not exceed \$30,000,000 (budgeted).

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The amounts are based on the estimated cost of projects currently underway that will continue under these Agreements.

BACKGROUND

LADWP is required to comply with state and federal regulatory agencies such as the United States Environmental Protection Agency, California Department of Toxic Substances Control, and Regional Water Quality Control Board, for site investigations and remediation services. LADWP utilizes environmental consulting firms on an as-needed basis to provide technical support for these services.

In order to comply with state and federal regulations, cleanup of LADWP facilities is conducted through voluntary or mandated cleanup actions. Additionally, site assessments are conducted to identify potential environmental issues prior to the purchase or sale of LADWP properties.

The activities conducted under these Agreements include site characterization, environmental risk assessments, toxicology studies, groundwater monitoring, well installation and associated modeling, and remediation system design and implementation.

ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION

Determine item is exempt pursuant to California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3). In accordance with this section, an activity is not subject to CEQA if it does not meet the definition of a project. Section 15378(b)(5) states that organizational or administrative activities that will not result in direct or indirect physical changes in the environment do not meet that definition. Therefore, the award of contracts for environmental site investigation and remediation services is not subject to CEQA.

CITY ATTORNEY

The Office of the City Attorney reviewed and approved the Agreements and Resolution as to form and legality.

B. Evaluation of Proposals

Six proposals were received in response to RFP No. 90780. The proposals were evaluated and scored by a three-person committee representing Environmental Affairs and the Valley Generating Station. The evaluation committee reviewed and evaluated all criteria except for financial stability, mandatory requirements, minimum requirements and fee schedules. Financial stability was evaluated by LADWP's Financial Services Organization (FSO), and the other criteria were evaluated by Supply Chain Services.

To assess the proposers' pricing, the consultants were required to provide responses to five technical scenarios that included cost proposals for each scenario. The submitted fee schedules were determined to be fair and reasonable based on the competitive RFP process. After all reviews, the evaluation committee has recommended award to the three highest rated proposers as the most qualified firms to perform the services.
