SUBJECT: Notice of Compliance Status Report – As of June 30, 2024

Attached is a status report on the Notice of Compliance (NOC) requests received and issued by the Labor Relations Office (LRO). The information is as of June 30, 2024.

An NOC is required if the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) seeks to contract work for outside services that include a labor component. The LRO is responsible for issuing an NOC as verification that proposed contracts are in compliance with contracting out procedures under applicable City Charter Section 1022 and a labor organization's Memorandum of Understanding (MOU). Per the applicable MOU language, the LADWP must notify its labor organizations of proposed contracts involving bargaining unit work.

It is the responsibility of the requesting LADWP Division to submit a completed NOC request to the LRO. The LRO will notify the appropriate labor organization as needed and will help facilitate any requested meeting(s) with the labor organization with the goal of securing agreement. The LRO does not typically issue an NOC for a contract containing bargaining unit work to a requesting Division until a mutual agreement to proceed is reached with the labor organization.

A total of thirteen (13) NOCs were issued from May 17 to June 30, 2024, totaling \$172,004,004. Since the last update provided to the Board of Water and Power Commissioners on June 11, 2024, the number of pending NOC Requests has increased from fifty-three (53), totaling \$3,469,661,907, to seventy-three (73), totaling \$6,026,150,078.¹ The increase in the total dollar amount of pending NOC Requests of

¹ Note that Financial Services Organization (FSO) resubmitted an NOC Request for Amendment No. 1 to Agreement 47614 for Services to Conduct Annual Actuarial and Advisory Services for Retirement, Retiree Medical and Death Benefits, advising that the NOC Request should have indicated an Amendment for an additional \$320,000 to the not-to-exceed amount of the contract, rather than \$200,000. Therefore, that

\$2,556,488,171 can be attributed to various new proposed contracts received, such as the following:

- Power Transmission and Distribution Invitation for Bid No. 534 for Services for Construction of Electrical Underground Conduit and Substructures, totaling \$385,877,031 (Line Item 47).
- Power System Planning Requisition No. 90729 for Commercial Direct Install Program, totaling \$330,000,000 (Line Item 52).
- Water Resources Agreement WR-24-1000 for LADWP and City of Los Angeles Department of Public Works, Bureau of Sanitation and Environment, for Groundwater Replenishment Project, totaling \$740,000,000 (Line Item 55).
- Power Capital Projects & External Generation Division Requisition No. 141345 for John Ferraro Building (JFB) Renovation and Modernization Project, totaling \$598,834,000 (Line Item 67).
