WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) proposes to enter into Agreement No. 47857 (Agreement) with Enervee Corporation (Enervee) for the Online Commercial and Residential Energy Efficient Product Marketplace Platform Services for a term of five years as a result of a competitive solicitation under Request for Proposal No. 90714R1; and

WHEREAS, LADWP evaluated the proposal of the sole bidder and found Enervee qualified to provide these services for the Online Commercial and Residential Energy Efficient Product Marketplace Platform Services; and

WHEREAS, Enervee has reviewed the services to be provided and incorporated in this Agreement, and represents that it has the qualifications, expertise, skills, and abilities to perform such work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that LADWP proposes to enter into the Agreement with Enervee in an amount not to exceed \$29,000,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to City Charter Section 1022, the Board of Water and Power Commissioners (Board) finds that it is more feasible to have the work performed by an independent contractor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Agreement approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, and filed with the Secretary of the Board, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Accounting Employee of LADWP, upon proper certification, is authorized and directed to draw demands on the Power Revenue Fund, in accordance with the terms of this Agreement and this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President or Vice President, or the General Manager, or such person as the General Manager shall designate in writing, and the Secretary, Assistant Secretary, or the Acting Secretary of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of LADWP.
