WHEREAS, through a competitive bid process, the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) issued a solicitation to procure the rental of dump trucks with operators on an as-needed basis, under Bid No. 405; and

WHEREAS, L.A.C. Motor Enterprises, Inc. (L.A.C.) is the lowest bidder due to Local Business Preference Program preference under Group A and the lowest bidder under Groups B, C, D, E, and F.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that L.A.C. is awarded Contract No. 405 (Contract) for a total amount not to exceed \$26,402,833 (budgeted) for a period of three years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to City Charter Section 1022, the Board of Water and Power Commissioners (Board) finds that it is more feasible to have the work performed by an independent contractor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Contract, approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Accounting Employee of LADWP, upon proper certification, is authorized and directed to draw demands on the Water Revenue Fund, in accordance with the terms of this Contract awarded pursuant to Bid No. 405 and this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President or Vice President, or the General Manager, or such person as the General Manager shall designate in writing, and the Secretary, Assistant Secretary, or the Acting Secretary of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute said contract for and on behalf of LADWP.
