WHEREAS, the City of Los Angeles, acting by and through the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP), proposes to enter into a Purchase and Sale Agreement and Escrow Instructions (Agreement) with Jordan Properties Group, LLC, a California Limited Liability Company, to acquire certain real property located at 9160 Jordan Avenue, Los Angeles, California 91311, generally described as Assessor's Parcel Number 2746-012-031, which includes one two-story industrial building consisting of approximately 25,374 square feet on approximately 41,120 square feet of land (Property); and

WHEREAS, LADWP desires to purchase the Property for a sum of \$7,600,000, plus escrow fees, closing costs, and related expenses; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Water and Power Commissioners (Board) has the authority, pursuant to Los Angeles City Charter Section 675(d)(1), to acquire by purchase, all real property necessary or convenient for LADWP purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves and authorizes the execution of the Agreement, approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, for a purchase price of \$7,600,000, plus customary escrow fees, closing costs, and related expenses.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President, or the Vice President, or the General Manager, or such person as the General Manager shall designate in writing, and the Secretary, Assistant Secretary, or the Acting Secretary of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute said Agreement for and on behalf of LADWP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that upon approval by the Board, the Director of Real Estate Services for LADWP or such person as the General Manager shall designate in writing, is authorized, empowered, and directed to execute escrow and other related documents necessary to carry out the transaction in accordance with the Agreement for and on behalf of LADWP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Accounting Employee of LADWP, upon proper certification, is authorized and directed to draw demands on the Power Revenue Fund to pay the purchase price and related expenses for the transaction, which include customary escrow fees, closing costs, and related expenses.
