Purpose

- Public Access to Clean Tap Water
- Promote Benefits of Tap Water
- Reduce Plastic Bottle Waste
- Support LA City Council Motions: CD 7, CD 2, and CD 12
- Achieve goal in Green New Deal

Hydration Station Model Examples



Eligibility

- LADWP water service non-residential customer
- LADWP approval of proposed placement
- Located in publicly accessible areas

Criteria

- High pedestrian traffic
- Maintain in operable, clean, and sanitary manner
- Install signage provided by LADWP
- Promote hydration station
- Reimburse \$5k for Indoor and \$10k for Outdoor Units

Roles & Responsibilities

HSIP Partner

- Identify locations
- Maintain inventory
- Procure, install, and maintain
- Cost of water
- Routine cleaning

LADWP

- Assess condition and operability
- Provide funds for procurement and installation
 - \$5,000 indoor HSs
 - \$10,000 outdoor HSs
- Education and outreach
- Water Quality Sampling

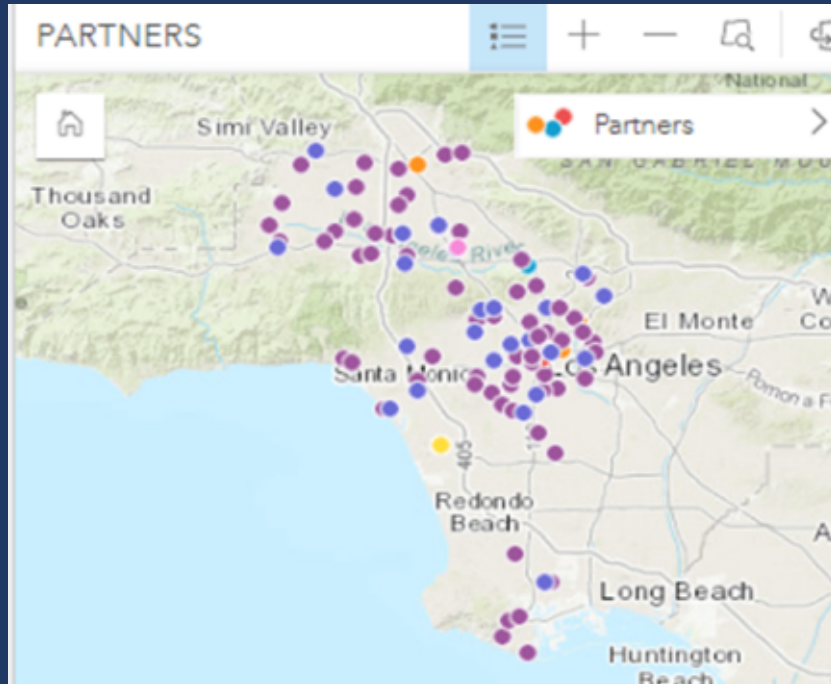

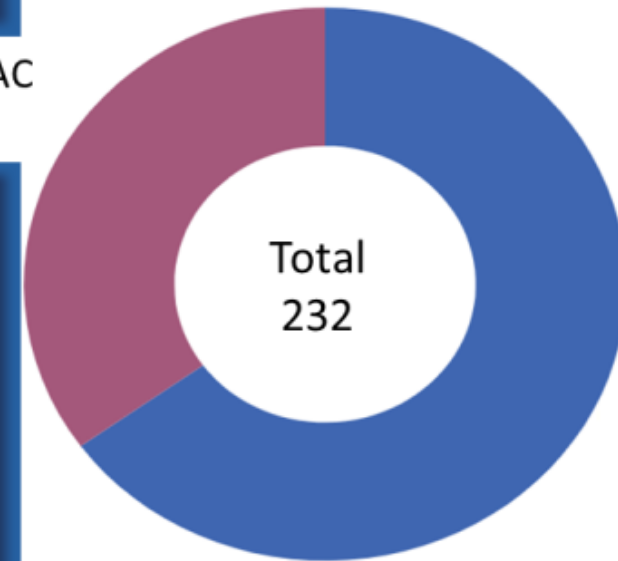

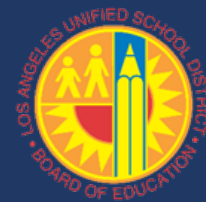

Program Budget

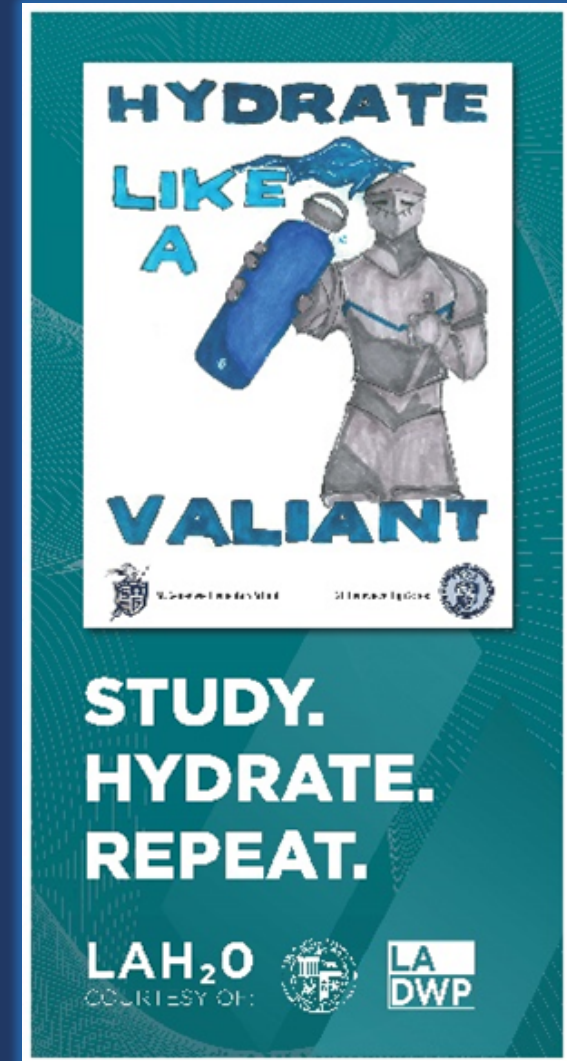
- \$5 million in funding
- \$1.3 million in reimbursements paid
- \$2.1 million reserved for pending projects
- \$1.5 million remaining program funds

Los Angeles Unified School District

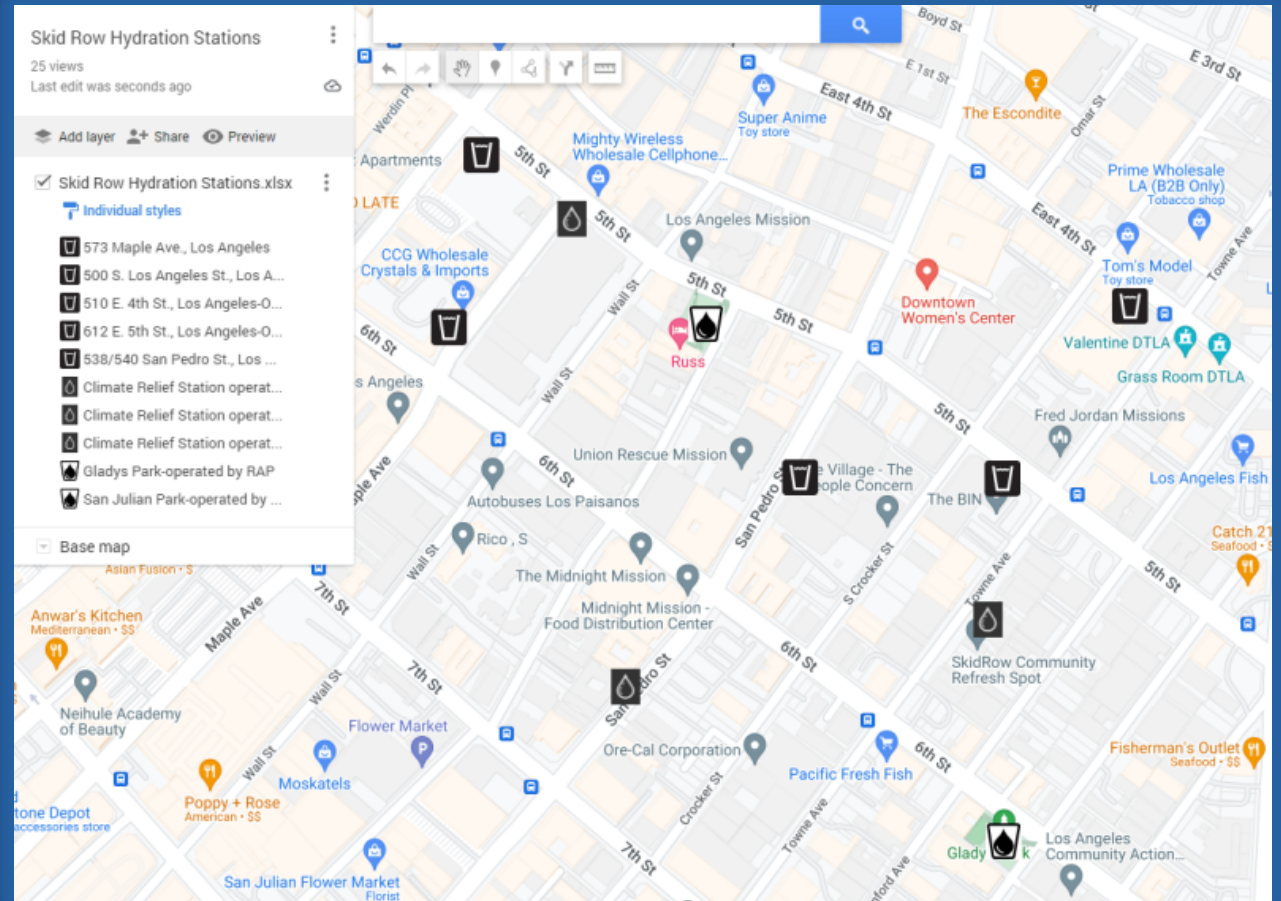
- Provide one new or enhanced hydration station per elementary school in LADWP territory
