WHEREAS, the Los Angeles Department of Water and Power (LADWP) proposes to enter into Agreement No. 47850 with KP Public Affairs, LLC for State Legislative Consulting Services for Water and Power Utility Advocacy for a term of one (1) year; and

WHEREAS, LADWP evaluated, contacted references and found KP Public Affairs, LLC as the most qualified to provide State Legislative Consulting Services for Water and Power Utility Advocacy; and

WHEREAS, KP Public Affairs, LLC has reviewed the services to be provided and incorporated in this Agreement, and represents that it has the qualities, expertise, skills and abilities to perform such work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that LADWP proposes to enter into Agreement No. 47850 with KP Public Affairs, LLC in an amount not to exceed \$260,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that pursuant to City Charter Section 1022, the Board of Water and Power Commissioners (Board) finds that it is more feasible to have the work performed by an independent contractor.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Agreement No. 47850, approved as to form and legality by the City Attorney, and filed with the Secretary of the Board, is hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Accounting Employee of LADWP, upon proper certification, is authorized and directed to draw demands on the Power Revenue Fund(s), in accordance with the terms of this agreement and this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the President or Vice President, or the General Manager, or such person as the General Manager shall designate in writing, and the Secretary, Assistant Secretary, or the Acting Secretary of the Board are hereby authorized and directed to execute said agreement for and on behalf of LADWP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any amendments to this Agreement, including any changes to sub-consultants (at any level) and consultant personnel will be provided to the Board through a publicly filed report within thirty days of LADWP approval.
