B. Evaluation of Proposals

LADWP received five proposals in response to RFP No. 90678 and all were deemed responsive. Financial stability was evaluated by LADWP's Financial Services Organization, and subcontracting requirements were evaluated by the Office of Small Business and Supplier Relations. All vendors received a passing score from both sections. The proposals were then evaluated by a five-member evaluation committee comprised of one Environmental Specialist Manager and four Water System Engineers.

To assess each proposer's anticipated pricing, Consultants were required to provide their personnel hourly rates, Phase 1 pricing for pre-construction and design projects, Phase 2 pricing to complete the design, and their company's Design-Build Fee for Phase 2 since the construction costs won't be finalized until the design is completed and LADWP has negotiated the Guaranteed Maximum Price. The vendor's pricing is determined to be fair and reasonable based upon the competitive process.

After an extensive evaluation of proposals, McCarthy/CDM Smith, Inc. was selected as the most qualified firm to perform design-build services for the Project.

C. Procurement History

There is no contract history for this service.

McCarthy/CDM Smith, Inc. is a joint venture created for this project and has not had a previous Agreement with LADWP.

D. Local Business Preference Program (LBPP)

The LBPP was included in this Agreement. McCarthy/CDM Smith, Inc. is a certified local business enterprise and was awarded the Contract because of the Local Business Preference of 8 percent.

E. Additional Outreach Efforts Taken

In addition to the original bid list, the following outreach efforts were taken:

- The RFP was posted on the City of Los Angeles Regional Alliance Marketplace for Procurement (RAMPLA) website.
- A Pre-Proposal Conference was held on April 27, 2022.

F. Small Business Enterprises (SBE)/Disabled Veterans Business Enterprises (DVBE)/Minority Business Enterprises (MBE)/Women Business Enterprises (WBE)/Other Business Enterprises (OBE) Participation

Water System is currently pursuing Drinking Water State Revolving Fund (DWSRF) financing for this project. As such, the procurement is subject to DWSRF regulations, and requirements, including a Good Faith Effort (GFE) outreach. The inclusion of GFE precluded the use of the Department’s SBE/DVBE participation program in this Project.

To satisfy DWSRF requirements and support additional subcontractor participation, the GFE requirements for this design-build project requires the contractor to conduct outreach in each of the 2 Phases of the Project.

- Phase 1: GFE required for design and preconstruction services
- Phase 2: GFE requires for the remaining design and all construction services at establishment of the Guaranteed Maximum Price

McCarthy/CDM Smith, Inc. successfully completed the steps required to demonstrate a GFE to reach out to available Disadvantaged Business Enterprises (DBE) and SBE/DBE/MBE/WBE/OBE firms. As a result, McCarthy/CDM Smith, Inc. committed to utilizing the following subcontractors for Phase 1 of the Project in the table below.

Once the Guaranteed Maximum Price has been established, McCarthy/CDM Smith, Inc. will be required to complete a second GFE outreach to available DBE and SBE/DBE/MBE/WBE/OBE firms for Phase 2 of the Project
